



Mullingar Golf Club - Tudenham Cup 2026

Competition Format

- The effective handicap index date for players is **January 1st 2026**. This will remain fixed for the duration of the competition, regardless of any subsequent changes to any player's WHI.
- All players must have a Fully Developed Handicap (20 counting scores)
- Each team will consist of five pairs.
- Lower combined handicap index of **12** per pair shall apply.
- Upper combined handicap index of **20** per pair shall apply.
- Maximum individual handicap index of **17** shall apply.
- Lowest player goes to Scratch and other player gets 90% of the difference per local rules
- The minimum age for any competitor is 18 on **1st January 2026**
- Matches will be played on a 3:2 home & away split as in the Barton Cup competition.
- Team on the top of the draw will have home advantage i.e. 3 matches at home.
- Sunday Tees (for reference these are the White Tees in Mullingar) to be used, not the back/championship tees. This will also apply for the final.
- Both Clubs to arrange and organise the matches, including any practice rounds (*see below*).
- Practice rounds for away teams are at the discretion of the home clubs, and subject to time-sheet availability, but it is anticipated that each home team will afford one practice round to each player from a visiting club.
- The player with the lowest handicap goes back to scratch -9/10 of the difference of full handicap rule applies to the remaining players in the fourball.
- Entry fee **€150** payable to Mullingar Golf Club – Men's Branch
